Specifications below are for an Bullet Catch for outdoor shooting range. Vendor must indicate if the equipment meets or exceeds the specifications. Explanations of variances must be included in bid response. Vendor must be an authorized dealer of equipment being bid.

Bid Specification	Meets Specification	Exceeds Specification	Explanation of Variances
Bullet catch must be between 70 and 80 feet wide.			
Top, sides, and bottom of the Bullet Catch must be constructed of Galvanized steel and contain granular rubber media to stop projectiles.			
Bullet catch must be rated to stop up to a 308 caliber round fired at close range.			
Bullet catch must be designed to be used with shooter ranging from 3 to 100 yards from the target.			
Delivery, installation, and training should be included in bid.
