
Special Considerations:

1. A minimum grade point average of 2.0 (0-4.0) must have been earned at WTCS.
2. Course credit will be awarded only if a grade of C or better has been earned in the HIT courses from WTCS.
3. The acceptance of WTCS credits applies only to students who have successfully completed or are eligible to take the Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT) exam. RHIT is a professional certification administered by the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) in the United States. Passing the exam results in licensure as a health information technician.
4. The acceptance of credits applies only to this Program-to-Program Articulation. Students may lose the articulated credits if they change their major.

5. For acceptance of equivalent courses, WTCS HIT Major Core courses must have been completed in 2011 or later. Prior to this period of time, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
6. This agreement is subject to review every three years from the effective date and if WTCS or UWL undergoes curriculum revision.
7. The agreement shall be effective on the 1st day of January 19, 2022 and shall automatically renew on each October 1, for an additional year, unless terminated with a one-year written notice.
8. If offered, it is recommended that students complete 20-804-212 to fulfill the College Algebra prerequisite for HIMIT 350.
