## *2019 MCU Member Scholarship*

NOTE: This scholarship is not available for MCU employees or their family members.

### **FAQ's**

- **When is the scholarship offered?** The scholarship is offered on an annual basis. The application deadline date is May 1st of each year.
- **What do we mean by "qualified"?** "Qualified" refers to any applicants that are currently enrolled in an accredited or campus-based auto mechanic education program.
- **Are international students eligible to apply?** As long as the international student candidate is currently enrolled in an accredited or campus-based auto mechanic education program, they are invited to apply.
- **Can military personnel eligible to apply?** We welcome all military service member candidates.
- **Do you need a letter of recommendation to apply?** No. We neither require nor accept letters of recommendation.
- **What is the application fee?** There is no application fee.

### The Scholarship Application Process

### Scholarship Requirements

- Minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) for High School Students
- Plan to enroll Part-time or Full-Time in an accredited not-for-profit OR for-profit 2- or 4- year college, university or graduate school during SPRING or FALL of scholarship cycleyear
- U.S. Citizen, Permanent Legal Resident, DACA or Eligible Non-Citizen (as defined by FAFSA)
- Merit-based scholarships available for undergraduate and graduate students
- All majors and graduate fields accepted
- Scholarship awards are \$1000 per application period

The applicant who is awarded the scholarship will be asked to share their progress on a quarterly basis. We at ezDinero Aspire look forward to hearing from you and fostering your academic success.
