First semester financial aid will be adjusted based on the number of credits student is enrolled in on this date.

Fall Financial Aid Book Deferment Ends

First Semester Disbursement of Grants and Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans
- **October 2**  
Registration for 8-week classes starting on Oct. 12 closes at 4:00 p.m.

No Title IV Financial Aid Repayment for Most Students After This Date

### Spring Semester 2027

- **November 23, 2026**  
Spring Financial Aid Book Deferment Opens
- **January 8**  
Spring Registration closes at 4:00 p.m.
- **January 18**  
First Day of Spring Term
- **February 9**  
Spring Financial Aid Book Deferment Ends
- **February 10: Date of Record\***  
Second semester financial aid will be adjusted based on the number of credits student is enrolled in on this date.
- **February 25**  
Second Semester Disbursement of Grants and Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans
- **March 5**  
Registration for 8-week classes starting on March 15 closes at 4:00 p.m.
- **April 2**  
No Title IV Financial Aid Repayment for Most Students After This Date

\* **Date of Record:** The payment of financial aid is based on the number of credits enrolled as of the date of record. If you add any classes after the date of record, your financial aid eligibility will not increase. If you are on a waiting list for a class, then you must be off the waiting list and registered for that class before the date of record in order to receive financial aid for that class. If you are registered for a class that starts after the date of record, you must be registered for that class before the date of record in order to receive financial aid for that class.
